

MOBILE CONSULAR MISSION FOR NAURU 27-28 February 2019

18 February 2019 - The Philippine Embassy is pleased to announce the details of the Mobile Consular Mission to Nauru.

Date : **27 – 28 February 2019** (Wednesday-Thursday)
 Time : **9:00AM to 5:00 PM**
 Venue : **Menen Hotel, Nauru**

The Embassy will accept applications (walk-in applicants) on a first come first serve basis for the mobile mission.

All applicants are required to bring all required documents to the venue (see instructions below). In the absence of any required document, your application cannot be processed.

Important: In the interest of public health safety, kindly observe due care and refrain from joining the mobile mission if unwell.

FOR PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

1. A **duly accomplished ePassport Application Form** (available in the Embassy's website www.philembassy.org.au) with the following required supporting documents:
 - a. Photocopy of data page of current passport; and
 - b. Photocopy of current visa.
2. **Additional requirements** for the following:

Category of Applicant	Requirements
For minors (below 18 years old)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Photocopy of Passport or Valid Government-issued ID of either parent.
For women changing status from <u>single to married</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certified True Copy of <u>Report of Marriage</u> obtained from the Philippine Embassy or Original and photocopy of Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)-authenticated Marriage Certificate.
For holders of: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - <u>Brown Passports</u> or passports issued prior to 01 May 1995 - <u>Green Passports</u> or passports issued after 01 May 1995 - <u>Machine Readable Passports (MRP)</u> issued from 2007 to 2010 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certified True Copy of Birth Certificate in Security Paper issued by PSA and a valid ID with picture
For those applying for a <u>new passport</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Certified True Copy of <u>Report of Birth</u> or original and photocopy of

	PSA-authenticated Birth Certificate and valid ID with picture
If a <u>dual citizen</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Photocopy of the Identification Certificate, Oath of Allegiance and Order of Approval • Original and photocopy of Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA)-authenticated Birth Certificate
If old passport is <u>lost and expired</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An Affidavit of Loss • Plus same requirements as for new passport
If old passport is <u>lost and valid</u>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • An Affidavit of Loss • Police Report • Plus same requirements as for new passport

4. Important Reminders:

- Only those with complete requirements will be processed.
- Bring a) **passport** b) **cash payment** of 108AUD for regular passport applications or 270AUD for lost/valid passport applications or postal money order payable to Philippine Embassy. Postal money orders can be purchased in any Auspost office; and
- Wear collared shirt and **no accessories**.
