Public Advisory No. 2006-1

Re: <u>Validity Requirement of Foreign and Philippine Passports for</u>
Philippine Entry

As per existing Philippine rules and regulations, please be guided by the following:

- 1. As a general rule, all incoming foreign passengers must be in possession of travel documents valid for at least six (6) months beyond the intended stay in the Philippines.
- 2. The Bureau of Immigration (BI) <u>may</u> allow admission after primary inspection of the following incoming passengers with no fine imposed on the carrier/airline:
 - a) **Foreign nationals** entering the country with passports valid for less than six (6) months;
 - b) **Filipino nationals** with expired passports who are unable to renew their travel document due to the absence of a consular establishment in their place of legal residence or for emergency reasons.
- 3. **Foreign nationals** traveling with expired passports will not be allowed entry and will immediately be returned to their port of origin and the carrier/airline will be imposed a fine of FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS PHILIPPINE CURRENCY (₱50,000.00) per passenger.
