Step 1

2.	Your Permanent Resident Card in Australia or other category of visa (if you do not have a PR or other category of visa, your fiancé(e)'s IC original and photocopy.
3.	Your Philippine passport, original and photocopy.
4.	Original NSO/PSA Birth Certificate with DFA apostille
5.	Any of these documents depending on your civil status:
	If you are single, Philippine Statistics Authority (PSA) Certificate of No Marriage Record (CENOMAR) with DFA apostille
	If you were previously married and annulled, either PSA amended marriage certificate with DFA apostille or Philippine Court's Certificate of Finality with DFA apostille)
	If you were previously married and divorced, either PSA amended marriage certificate with DFA apostille or Philippine Court's Certificate of Finality (DFA apostille)
	If you are a widow or widower, Original PSA Death Certificate of deceased spouse

- 6. If you are age 18-20 years old, Affidavit of Parental Consent, notarized by a notary public where the signing parent resides and apostilled by DFA or DFAT
- 7. If you are age 21-25 years old, Affidavit of Parental Advice

Both contracting parties should be both Filipino citizens.

Step 2

10 day publication after successful review of all requirements

Step 3

Notification of compliance with all requirements, including 10-day publication

Step 4

Notarial fee for application for marriage license AUD45.00 each for groom and bride (to be notarized at the Embassy on the date of filing)

Fee for solemnization of marriage AUD108.00 (to be paid on the date of marriage)
