The Embassy will <u>now</u> start accepting applications until **640** slots are filled up for the mobile mission. All applicants are required to:

- (a) <u>secure an appointment/slot</u> with the Embassy (see instructions below). Due to limited data capture equipment, **walk-in applicants** (or those without appointments) **WILL NOT be accommodated.**
- (b) <u>submit all required documents</u>. In the absence of any required document, your application <u>cannot</u> be processed.

During the mobile mission, <u>only</u> the following consular services are available:

- (a) attend to **passport** applications,
- (b) administer the oath of allegiance to petitioners for dual citizenship and
- (c) register qualified overseas Filipino voters.

<u>Important</u>: In the interest of public health safety, kindly observe due care and refrain from joining the mobile mission if unwell.

## I. FOR PASSPORT APPLICATIONS

#### A. HOW TO SECURE AN APPOINTMENT

To secure an appointment, please **send by post** the following to the **Philippine Embassy**, **1 Moonah Place**, **Yarralumla**, **ACT 2600**.

Applications sent electronically or via email will <u>not</u> be accepted.

- A duly accomplished ePassport Application Form (available in the Embassy's website <u>www.philembassy.org.au</u>) with the following required supporting documents:
  - a. Photocopy of data page of current passport; and
  - b. Photocopy of Australian visa.

- Only those with <u>complete requirements</u> will be granted an appointment.
- Information on the <u>appointment time/day</u> will be emailed to the applicant <u>on or</u> <u>before 18 June 2018</u>.
- Applicants are advised to check their <u>spam folder</u> as the Embassy's confirmation email is sometimes misdirected to the said folder. Please note that the Embassy has an auto-reply for all emails received which is <u>not</u> a confirmation of your appointment/slot.
- If an email appointment has <u>not been received</u>, applicants are requested to email the Embassy through <u>mobilemission@philembassy.org.au</u>. Please note that all queries will only be responded to via the email address provided.

## II. FOR DUAL CITIZENSHIP APPLICATIONS

Please visit <u>https://www.philembassy.org.au/dual-citizenship</u> for the complete list of requirements. Only those with approved applications <u>and</u> confirmed appointments will be allowed to take the oath during the mobile mission.

Please note that the Embassy has an auto-reply for all emails received which is **not** a confirmation of your appointment for the oath-taking ceremony. It is your personal responsibility to make sure that your application has been received and that you have been scheduled for the oath-taking ceremony.

All dual citizenship applicants who wish to <u>apply for Philippine passports</u> must also <u>secure appointments</u> (see application procedure above). **The mobile mission is unable to accommodate dual citizen applicants who have not secured appointments.** 

## III. FOR OVERSEAS VOTER REGISTRATION

The registration/certification of qualified overseas Filipinos has resumed for purposes of the 2019 National Election.

All citizens of the Philippines, who are abroad or will be abroad during the thirty (30) day voting period from 13 April to 13 May 2019, at least eighteen (18) years of age on the day of the elections and not otherwise disqualified by law, may register.
