\$Be mindful of your VISA restrictions.

§Renew your PASSPORT year before expiry date.

§Know the terms and conditions of your CONTRACT.

§Inform first your employer of any WORKPLACE problem.

§Be mindful of VISA prescriptive periods for:

*Lodging Complaint: 28 days from termination

*Search for new Employer/Sponsor: within

-60 days (if visa is issued on or after 19 November 2016)

-90 days (if visa is issued before 19 November 2016)

§Invest in SKILLS enhancement programs.

§Actively participate in COMMUNITY events.

§Maintain communication with FAMILY members.

§Attend regularly to SPIRITUAL needs.

§Keep a HEALTHY lifestyle.

§Participate in EMBASSY/CONSULATE/POLOsponsored events.

§Participate in FINANCIAL LITERACY and REINTEGRATION programs.

\$Leave Australia before the EXPIRATION of your visa.

Some reminders while in Australia:

When crossing the street:

- You should always use pedestrian crossings where possible.
- Remember to look right, then left and then right again when walking across the street.

When driving:

- Australians drive on the left side of twoway roads.
- If you commit a traffic offence, you may incur demerit points against your driver's licence. Demerit points remain on your licence record for three years from the date of offence.
- All drivers and passengers in the car must wear seatbelts.
- Speed limits are strictly enforced in Australia.

Know your entitlements:

- · Check your superannuation benefits.
- An employee gets a long service leave after a long period of working for the same employer. Most employees' entitlement to long service leave comes from long service leave laws in each State or Territory.

Don't forget to:

- Invest in a good health insurance.
- Register with the Philippine Embassy or nearest Consulate-General.
